


# OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19






At Elevation, safety has always been one of our core values. This remains of the utmost important during this season. Listed below is what we will be doing to help keep our dancers, families, and staff safe. We will update our policies as needed over time.

- We will be closing our lobby at both of our locations to eliminate the number of people gathered in a small area. If you need to speak to someone at the front desk, we will arrange for you to come inside or we will meet you outside depending on the circumstance. If it is your first time at Elevation, we will help give you a brief tour between classes so that you can see the space while also helping us maintain small numbers of people gathered.
  - Dancers will be dropped off at the door. In Anderson, dancers will use the main entrance. In Pendleton, dancers will use the back door by the ramp for classes in that studio or use the front door for classes in the front studio. If you are unsure of which room your class is in, just let us know.
  - Dancers will receive hand sanitizer when coming into class and also upon exiting of class.
  - Dancers will be given a spaced out spot to dance on during class to help maintain social distancing.
  - Partner work and shared props have been eliminated from our instructional time. Any props used are only used by one student and are disinfected before their next use.
  - Between classes, we will be cleaning commonly touched surfaces and disinfecting the air.
  - Our bathrooms will be for emergencies only. This will help us to limit the amount of cleaning that is needed.
  - Water fountains have been closed. We will also not be selling water, Gatorade, or snacks during this time. So, please bring water with you if needed.

- Masks are not required for dancers at this time. The CDC does not recommend high-intensity exercising in masks. If your dancer would like to wear a mask to class, they are more than welcome.
  - Family members that need to enter the studio will need to wear a mask. If you are unable to wear a mask, we can accommodate you outside.
  - EDC Staff members will be wearing masks for your safety.
  - Anybody that is showing any symptoms of COVID-19 will be asked to stay home.
  - We have an option for virtual classes for those who are not yet ready to be in a classroom setting.
  - We will be capping the number of dancers in classes so that social distancing can be maintained.
